We are now two months into a new school year at STCCS. It is so good to have students and teachers back in the classroom! The sounds of small feet excitedly rushing into their classrooms in our primary end, the happy greetings between friends as a new day starts, students pouring over group projects – sharing ideas and enjoying the thrill of learning . . . and so much more! These are what we have longed for and are so grateful for after a difficult year and a half impacted by Covid.

STCCS prioritizes our students, and it is a profound privilege to teach them about their Father's world. Our mission is *to know and serve every student*, *encouraging them to reach their God-given potential*. God has given us a fantastic, dedicated staff to take care of the educational needs of each student. - We have also seen God answer prayer as we strive to better support all our students.
  We are excited about our ever-growing Student Services Program which serves a large

  teachers, four Personal Support Workers, one Educational Assistant, and one
  Behavioural Support Worker provide our students with the care and support to help them
  reach their God-given potential.
- As we grow and strive to better serve our students, the demands on our leadership team
  have also grown. Recently, we were able to expand our administration team to include a
  Director of Operations. This position will help us manage many day-to-day activities
  including enrolment, finances, and facilities.
- We feel extremely fortunate to have two wonderful campuses to serve our growing school community. At 77 Fairview, we welcome our kindergarten to grade 5 students in our newly renovated "North Campus." While at 345 Fairview, our "South Campus", we are blessed to support our students in a fully accessible, modern building with a massive gym and great learning spaces.
