FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



1. Who sends their children to STCCS?

There is no such thing as a 'typical' STCCS family! Our students represent a wide variety of cultures and backgrounds, and we are blessed by the diversity of our school community. Our families worship at a wide variety of local churches of varied denominations.

2. Who teaches at STCCS?

All of our teachers are devoted Christ-followers who see their teaching as a clear calling from the Lord. All teachers are certified members of the Ontario College of Teachers and have Education degrees from accredited universities in Canada or the United States.

3. Is STCCS accredited?

STCCS is registered with the Ontario Ministry of Education and delivers the Ontario curriculum at every grade level. STCCS is also a member of three supporting organizations: EDVANCE (formerly the Ontario Alliance of Christian Schools), Christian Schools Canada (CSC), and Christian Schools International (CSI).

4. What additional opportunities are offered to engage students?

STCCS aims to provide a wide variety of opportunities for students to discover and develop their God-given potential. We feature strong Athletics, Drama, Music, and Visual Arts programs, and consistently develop new options to serve our students. Chess Club, Student Council, Battle of the Books, Coding Club, and Intramural Sports are some of the newest additions to our extra-curricular programming for the year.

As a privately funded Christian school, our budget is comprised of tuition fees, donations, support from various churches, and fundraising. Our annual tuition fee structure is set each year by the Board of Directors and approved by the membership in a Spring financial meeting. Our Board is committed to serving families with a vibrant tuition assistance program and the opportunity to apply for bursaries. As we launch our second campus and high school, we are thrilled to announce that we will host one tuition rate for all students, JK to Grade 12. This means that if you have children attending STCCS across any grades, you will pay ONE rate.

TUITION MODEL
