# first DAY

### FIRST DAY DROP OFF

On the first day of school, our students in Grades 1-8 can enjoy some time together outside in the school yard until the bell rings at 8:30am. Please remember that supervised drop off begins at 8:10am.

Our Kindergarten students will be met at the Kindergarten Drop Off Area by a school staff member and will be lead inside to their classroom.

Our High School students can be dropped off at the front doors of our South Campus and may come directly inside. Staff will be waiting in the Learning Commons to greet them.

### PHYS ED SHIRTS

We will distribute gym shirts to students in our middle and high school during the first week of school. **Please send your child to school with a gym shirt they can change into for PE until they receive their STCCS phys ed t-shirt**. We plan to send out an order form for more shirts in the first few weeks of school for parents who would like their child(ren) to own more than one phys ed shirt. These will be at a cost to parents.

### CHAPEL

Our back to school chapel will take place on Tuesday morning at **9:30am at our South Campus** only. All parents are warmly welcomed to join us for the first South Campus chapel service of the year. We recognize that the timing between drop off and chapel is not ideal for parents, however we are prioritizing our students and their transition back into the classroom. If you cannot make it to Tuesday's chapel, you are welcome to join us for our regularly scheduled weekly Monday chapel at 8:45am on September 12th when Mr. Gilbert will include a special chapel message for parents.

North Campus will begin their weekly Monday morning chapel services on Monday, September 12th.

### DAILY SCREENING

We are thankful for the relaxing of regulations and restrictions, however the Ontario Government still requires the screening of students, staff, and visitors before they enter the school. Please follow this <u>link</u> to use the return to school screening tool if you are unsure if your child is able to attend school.

We ask that anyone who is feeling sick or unwell stay home until their symptoms have improved for 24 hours. We ask our community to keep immune compromised students and our staff members in mind as they make decisions regarding their child's attendance at school.
